### **The role**

This role provides teachers with the opportunity to work with SEMH students who are keen but in need of a little extra support to realise their full potential. Tuition will be delivered in the students' homes hence travel will be required as we work across multiple local authorities such as Croydon, Merton, Wandsworth, etc.

Tuition will be aligned with the national curriculum. Lessons will mainly be centred around Entry level, Functional skills level 1 and 2 and GCSE in the near future. The tutor will need to have a current understanding of the national curriculum and must be prepared to deliver sessions aligned with this on a 1-1 basis in English, Maths and Science. We anticipate that work will be in chunks of 4 to 5 hours per day.

You will be expected to work effectively with both teaching and support staff at all levels as well as with parents/carers, students, and external agencies. Training in school systems and practices will be provided. From September 2022, teaching duties will also include a small specialist KS5 Provision.
